DATES: Sunday, Feb. 23; Wednesday, Feb. 26; Sunday, March 1, 2020

PURPOSE: Increase children's awareness of the need for the gospel in Hispanic countries.

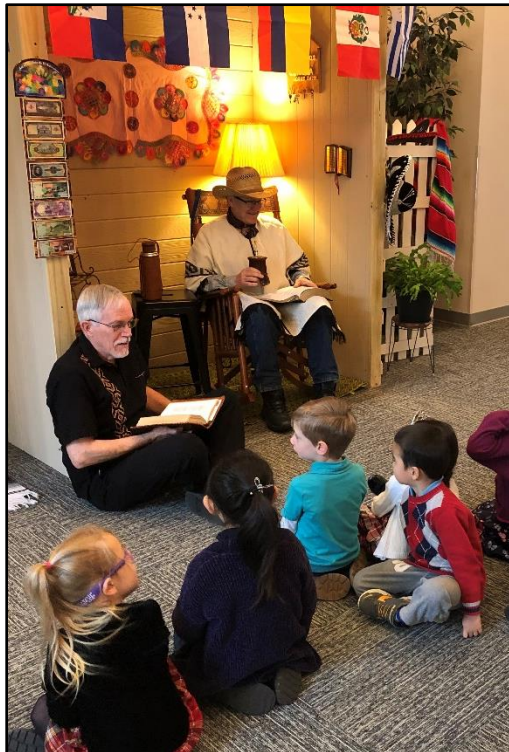
PROJECT: Build an Interactive Hispanic Display.



CONSTRUCTION: A small lean-to chalet (approximately 6' deep x 8' high x 9' wide) divided in two rooms. One side will reflect a "Christian side" with someone seated reading the Bible aloud in Spanish. The other side of the chalet will show what a Catholic home would look like: rosary, 'candle' in front of a niche with a statue or picture of Mary.



VISUALS: Hispanic costumes, hats, wall pictures of typical scenes, tapestries could be hung up on either side of the chalet. Plants could be placed on either end of the chalet. Flags will be hung above the chalet.



AUDIO/VISUALS:

- Chromebooks will be used so children can look up the capital cities of each Hispanic country and identify its flag. The Bible.is app will be used to select a language in a Hispanic country and a portion of Scripture read virtually.
- Romans 10:14-15 will be displayed on the table: “How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? ...How shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? ...How shall they hear without a preacher? ...How shall they preach, except they be sent?”
- A video of a children’s VBS activity in Paraguay will be shown.
- Children will hear specific Scriptures to use with those who base their religion on what they do for God rather than what He did for us through his Son Jesus Christ.

TACTILE: The children will be given a small maraca from Mexico.
